Student must:

- Be registered with UGA Disability Resource Center
- Have a minimum 2.0 GPA
- Be enrolled during awarded semester
- Have completed 30 hours of coursework
- Have a disability due to a chronic illness

Applications must include the following items:

- Application form
- Essay of no more than 500 words
(see below for essay suggestions)
- Official or unofficial transcript
- Letter of recommendation

Essay Guidelines

Your essay should be no more than 500 words and should address how you intend to use the award monies. The following questions are suggestions to help guide you in your writing:

- If you were asked to present to a group of people who knew nothing about disabilities, what information would you give them?
- How would you inspire younger students with a disability or chronic illness?
- What is the most important thing you have learned as a college student with a disability?
- How has your disability impacted your life and educational career?
